The cost to be a curling or golf member at Glendale provides excellent value for the money spent.

An Olympic winter sport, curling is both fun and affordable. “The popularity of curling is on the rise in Canada as more and more people see the sport as a great way to stay fit and keep busy over the long winter,” Macklin said. “With helpful instruction available, eight leagues of various skill levels to join and an encouraging and supportive membership, Glendale curling is for everyone.”

For a limited time, both new and returning curlers are invited to take advantage of a trial membership offer. For only \$100, a prospective member will be taught how to curl safely and properly, learn basic game strategy and have a chance to get out on the ice with existing Glendale Members. (basic curling equipment is provided). Open houses will also be held on the following dates: Oct. 12, 14, 17, 19 and 21 from 4 p.m. – 9 p.m. and October 16 from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.

Glendale Golf and Country Club is located at 401 Mount Albion Road, just off the Red Hill Valley Parkway (Green Hill Avenue exit), and is approximately 20 minutes or less from nearly everywhere in the greater Hamilton area.
